February 13, 2014 (Winnipeg) — Macabre twists, eerie misfortune and sinister spells of bad luck await anyone bizarre enough to miss this year's Winnipeg Comedy Festival, delivering a lethal dose of laughs to audiences from April 7-13.

Celebrating its unlucky 13th birthday in appropriately frightful fashion, this year's Fest has assembled another killer roster of comics to lend a hand with ghastly gags and assorted "Gorey" details. From wicked wits and mordant misfits to creepy cut-ups and shadowy satirists, the lineup promises a dark and dastardly spin on one of the city's most infectious events.

No stranger to beastly behaviour, film and TV fave Tom Green brings his oddball charm to this year's late gala on Saturday, April 12, showcasing the "Special Delivery" of a roster of similarly singular talents, including super-droll festival regular Jon Steinberg.

Earlier the same night, *Match Game* host Darrin Rose turns Pantages Playhouse into his own personal man-cave, exploring macho attitudes and male ego at the über-masculine "Bro Show". (Don't worry: you can balance out all that testosterone at "The No Bro Show" later the same night, when host Tricia Cooper gives the last word to an all-female lineup.)

On Friday, April 11, TV's Daryn Jones hosts "First World Problems"—an evening of wry satire and observational humour—then our panel of prognosticators turn their gaze to the future at the The Future Show gala the same night. Over at the Gas Station Arts Centre, find out whether "Size Matters" as dimunitive Las Vegas legend Tanyalee Davis returns home to perform with a lineup of comics representing different points on the body-type spectrum.

Bring your appetite to the opening gala on Thursday, April 10, when one-woman tsunami Sandra Shamas hosts the culinary-themed "Food, Glorious Food" showcase, which also stars comedian Cris Nannarone, host of the Cooking Channel's *Best in Chow*. Dine and laugh at Gastrocomique at Fusion Grill on Wednesday, April 9, or for an even earlier start on the festivities, catch the Comedy Aces showcase at McPhillips Station Casino on Tuesday, April 8.

Throughout the week, be sure to check out WCF crowd-pleasers like the Winnipeg Show (featuring a scary-good lineup of locals), the adult-themed Dark and Stormy Show (in which comics can indulge their "baser" instincts), and the WCF debut of a live taping of CBC Radio's hit sketch program *The Irrelevant Show*.

Catch solo gigs by Derek Edwards, Elvira Kurt and Dave Hemstad (among many others), fly by the seat of your pants with Doctor Whom & The Lords of Improv (hosted by CRUMBS founder Stephen Sim), or hit the Cinematheque for a film festival of "N(one)-Hit Wonders" (think Mel Brooks' *The Producers* and The Marx Brothers' *Duck Soup*), curated by *Kids in the Hall* vet Kevin McDonald.

Plus, as the fates would have it, we have managed to create some very lucky breaks for local acts. In fact, while the Chinese may have branded 2014. The Year of the Horse, we dub it The Year of the Winnipeg Comic. So our dour marketing campaign hides an ear-to-ear grin.

Delivered in partnership with CBC Television and Frantic Films, each of our themed galas will begin with a tailored set from a Winnipeg comic, which will air as brand new Winnipeg Comedy Festival web content on cbc.ca. It's a chance for national coverage and a slot on the main event. Congrats to Dan Verville, Chantel Marostica, Matt Falk, Paul Rabliauskas, and Big Daddy Tazz for making the final cut.

And Hot Thespian Action's Jane Testar and Jacquie Loewen join the cast of The Irrelevant Show for a special evening of sketches from the hit CBC Radio brand. Don't worry, we're not walking away from The Debaters, they're back. We think The Irrelevant Show has legs just as long, and we're hoping for a yearly visit from our new gang, too.

And what better time than the 50th anniversary of Doctor Who to introduce a new show? We're so sure of The Irrelevant Show being a hit we've already ordered a spin off. Doctor Whom & the Lords of Improv features our Irrelevant cast, with stellar local Stephen Sim along for the spacey trip.

We've really piled on the local shows, meaning this year will be a very tragic year for big spenders. The Upper Deck shows at the King's Head Pub mean top draw comedy at pickpocket prices.

But our obsession with locals doesn't mean Canada's best comics are dead to us. Along with the many Very Big Deals you can see all of Canada's best, in venues large and small. This year, it's more up close and personal, with the best Rumors showcases EVER and a solo show from the indefatigable Elvira Kurt, who's become so beloved and well known to Winnipeggers she might just have to drop her last name! And Fringe Fest hit "I Hate Bill Pats" gets reworked and remounted — a dark tale with a bittersweet end.

Bruce Clark hosts Just Kidding!, a thrilling panel discussion on the question of the limits of comic speech that will bring us to the finish of a thirteenth festival that includes those three pillars of standup gold, Best of the Fest, Dark and Stormy and Comedy Aces.

Okay, so maybe it's not that grim and ghastly after all. But the world is still going to hell and if it helps, I'm in a very bad mood.




